- 1. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. by Chair Goodridge, with the Pledge of Allegiance.

  - **d.** <u>Ansted Park:</u> Discussion on extending parking lot, ramp is completed, waiting for response from Fire on burn. Plans for dog park under discussion possible adding 2 more acres.
  - e. Samaria Park: water test to be completed on February 12.
  - **f.** White Park: Great shape. Talk to 3B about contract next month.
  - **g.** Parmelee Park: Waiting for skate park to be finished.
  - **h.** <u>Indian Creek</u>: none. Laurie noted bluebird houses need to be cleaned/refurbished possible scout project?
